












NVAFC Case Study BBB RS29 1971 History of Racism in Britain Timeline **Immigration Act** passed which further restricted migration from 1970 1979 Commonwealth countries. Mangrove Nine A protest sparked by Blair Peach was killed frequent police raids on the Mangrove during an anti-racist restaurant in Notting Hill, London demonstration. There were resulted in nine protesters being charged renewed calls for an 1972 with incitement to riot. The trial of the investigation into police 30.000 deported Ugandan Mandrove Nine was a landmark in British violence in this case in Asians with British passports legal history. After 8 hours the jury 2019. came to Britain following the acquitted all defendants of the main overthrow of Milton Obote of charge and brought the first judicial Uganda by Idi Amin. acknowledgement of the evidence of racial hatred in the Metropolitan police.

## 1970


**Bernard Coard** published landmark pamphlet 'How the West Indian Child is Made Educationally Subnormal in the British School System. This inspired a movement for equal access to educational opportunity for Black children and the establishment of Saturday schools.


# 1972


**Oval 4** four Black men were stopped by plain-clothes, white police officers using the '<u>sus</u> <u>laws'</u> because 'it was clear they intended to pick the pockets of passengers.' No evidence, resulted in 2 years imprisonment. Their convictions were quashed in 2019.

#### 1976

Invention of term 'Political Correctness' by tabloid press Bus driver Robert Relf put up sign outside house 'For Sale to an English family only' contravening the Race Relations Act and being imprisoned for contempt of court when he refused to take it down. The tabloid press used his imprisonment as ammunition to argue against what they called 'political correctness'. The National Front organised a campaign in his support.
